

## O2 Open



### What is it?

O2 Open is a benefit scheme for our highest value corporate customer's employees.

Until 31st July 2010 we will be offering extra credit for all new connections on the O2 Open scheme.

O2 Open gives the employee's a choice of rewards including a credit on their mobile account after 30 days of connection.

### What do customers get?

The new offering is:

- £125 for a pay monthly handset tariff over £20 per month
- £100 for a pay monthly handset tariff at £20 or under
- £100 for a Simplicity running for 12 months (Simplicity tariff is SIM only)

The £10 for 30 day Simplicity tariff stays the same.

You can choose any Pay Monthly handset including the iPhone 3GS, BlackBerry and the Palm Pre. At the same time as you join O2 Open, you can also benefit from:

- 50% off a Pay & Go dongle (when you purchase any Pay Monthly handset, Home Broadband or Simplicity)
- Home broadband from £7.50 a month
- Priority benefits - Our customers can get Priority tickets to The O2 and O2 Academy venues up to 48 hours before general release
